In addition pupils will need the following:

- Farringtons School Bag, Year 7 & 8\*\*
- Strong plain black rucksack or holdall (no logos), Years 9 – 11
- Plain green or black scarf (optional)
- Full PE Kit 7 Equipment (please see separate list)

### PLEASE NOTE THAT:

- No jewellery is permitted except 1 wrist watch, 1 plain silver or gold ear stud in each ear lobe.
- Hairstyles should conform to a reasonable norm as determined by the Head. The following are not allowed: patterned, sculpted styles or too closely shaved cuts (grade 0 – 2), or unnaturally coloured dyed hair. Long hair must be tied back in lessons where health and safety concerns are paramount. Pupils must be clean shaven. Side burns must not be lower than the bottom of the ear.
- False eyelashes and false painted nails are not permitted.
- All possessions, including non-uniform clothes, must be clearly marked with owner's name. In a school community it is impossible to trace un-named articles.
- Valuable pens, watches and items of jewellery should not be brought into school.
- Any uniform left uncollected in lost property for over one term will be recycled or given to charity.

- 1 pair of football or rugby boots (kite mark studs, not blades) suitable for football and rugby
- Members of the Cricket Team will require long white cricket trousers
