

Uniform

Members of the Sixth Form must be smartly dressed at all times.



Black or navy suit to be purchased from the FPA Uniform Shop.
Suit to be worn with a plain white or colour shirt (not t-shirt or jumper).
School tie to be worn with buttoned up collared shirt.
A white shirt is required for formal occasions.
Black shoes, socks or tights.
In cold weather a plain black v neck slipover may be worn.

Please Note:

- Hairstyles should conform to a reasonable norm as determined by the Head. The following are not allowed: patterned, sculpted styles or too closely shaved cuts (grade 0 – 2), or unnaturally coloured dyed hair. Long hair must be tied back in lessons where health and safety concerns are paramount. Pupils must be clean shaven. Side burns must not be lower than the bottom of the ear.
- The general appearance of pupils should conform to a reasonable norm, which, if necessary, shall be at the discretion of the Head. It is important that each pupil should project an image that would bring credit to them and the School.
- Any pupil who is not appropriately dressed may be sent home to change. All shoulders should be covered, no trainers or casual footwear. Clothes must not be too short or too tight fitting.
- All possessions, including non-uniform clothes, must be clearly marked with owner's name. In a school community it is impossible to trace un-named articles.
- Valuable pens, watches and items of jewellery should not be brought into school.
- Shoes with small, sharp heels may not be worn in School at any time.
