

Vacancy for an Assistant Minibus Administrator/ Relief Driver (term time only) Required for September 2025

For this dual role we are looking to recruit a strong administrator and committed, reliable and experienced driver to be available for adhoc driving shifts to cover planned absences and staff sickness, sometimes at short notice. You would also shadow the current administrator, to learn about the day-to-day organisation of the minibus service with a view to taking over the role in the future.

Salary range - £17.89 to £18.41 per hour

You would provide the school with an effective and efficient minibus service to our pupils and parents. This would include ensuring the safe, efficient and compliant operation of the fleet, arranging servicing and inspections, co-ordinating the routes for our drivers.

Our minibus drivers work two shifts; the morning shift is 6.30am - 8.30am and the evening shift is 3.30pm - 5.30pm during term time. Our relief drivers could be asked to cover either shifts or both.

There may be scope to cover airport runs and drive for our co-curricular activities delivered through our Floreat programme.

- Have excellent communication and interpersonal skills with pupils, staff and parents
- Collect and drop off pupils safely on school runs
- Be available for occasional educational visits
